



OLPH Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct

Responsibilities:

- Remain in the spectator area during the game.
- Respect decisions made by the game officials.
- Be free of drugs, alcohol, and tobacco at all youth practices, events, and games.
- Remember that all players are children and are playing for their enjoyment.
- Be a positive role model by supporting teams. Do not shout criticism to the players, coaches, or officials. Make no derogatory comments or gestures.
- If you are upset about a game, please allow yourself 24 hours before discussing the problem with the coach. This allows time to cool off and approach the situation in a positive manner.
- Although all players will have ample opportunities to play most games, it is at the coach's discretion to provide the maximum success for the individual student as well as the team.
- All physicals must be turned in before the first game.
- All athletic fees must be turned in before the first game.
- Academics before athletics. All athletes are expected to maintain a grade average of 77 or higher in all classes to participate.
- All school uniforms and equipment must be returned in good shape and in a timely manner.
- It is important for you to communicate to the coach if your athlete can not make a practice or game. Missing practices can impact their amount of playing time.
- Please pick your athlete up ON TIME from all practices/games or they will be sent to after care when applicable.
- Be willing to assist in service activities at least twice during a season. One of these times will be spent cleaning / maintaining the facilities and equipment that athletes use for their sport.
- Be willing to volunteer at games as needed. Many hands make light work.

Enforcement: If the above commitments are not met, a conference will be required with the coach and Athletic Director, and/or Principal to discuss such behavior and what further actions are necessary.
