- Working with students on plays, programs and concerts as well as other events that include music.
- In coordination with the pastor, coordinate music for all masses as needed.
- Teaching students about the cultural and historical importance of music.
- Keeping Lessons and Objectives posted on the school's learning management system, FACTS.
- Recording and reporting on students' progress in FACTS.
- Monitoring inventory and sourcing art supplies, as needed.
- Attending faculty and parent-teacher meetings.
